

Abu Kaddour Restaurant: The restaurant has an excellent reputation in the world of Siriah and serves several other local dishes.



The ways to reach Makkah are divided as follows:

- 1- Public transport: by buses, trains, taxis, and cars that are rented through smart applications.
- 2- Private transport: Lots of citizens and residents use their private cars to travel to Makkah from different cities in the Kingdom. Private cars are also rented for this purpose. During the Ramadan and Hajj seasons, these cars are parked in designated parking lots at the entrances to Makkah Al-Mukarramah. Visitors are then directed to dedicated buses which transport them to Al Masjid Al Haram.

Swissotel Al Maqam Makkah: It is one of the hotels located within the towers of the house directly opposite Al Masjid Al Haram.
















Hotels near Landmarks



Makarem um Al-Qura Hotel: The hotel is close to the Holy Haram, and it is 5.1 km from the Makkah Museum.

Miral Hotel: The hotel is 650 meters (4 minutes) from Makkah Mall, which is considered one of the most important shopping points in the holy city of Makkah.

Al Salam Commercial Market: It is considered one of the ancient markets in Makkah Al-Mukarramah This market is located in the Aziziyah district and includes a variety of shops that sell-clothes, accessories and souvenirs.

Makkah Mall: Makkah Mall is a large shopping center that provides great and comprehensive purchasing opportunities residents of Makkah the for Al-Mukarramah and visited it, Makkah Mall works as a shopping center and entertainment center, and is considered one of the best modern malls in Makkah that includes the largest international brands in the city. Located in Al Aziziyah district, this mall has more than 140 stores in addition to many restaurants and cafes.

Abraj Al Bait Mall: Abraj Al Bait Mall Makkah is one of the world-famous brands, and is considered the largest shopping center in Makkah, and it is also the third tallest building in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, and the fifth tallest building in the world, as the mall is one of a group of towers called "Abraj Al Bait", those towers that are characterized by the presence of the highest clock in the world, which reaches a height of about 600 meters. Abraj Al Bait Mall consists of five floors.

City Centre Makkah: City Centre Makkah is one of the modern commercial centers in Makkah that was built in 1432 AH and opened in 1433, and this mall is located in Al-Mansour neighborhood. It is also one commercial entertainment centers because it contains many famous brands in various activities, as well as containing the largest ice hall in Makkah Al-Mukarramah, in addition to the amusement park, the billiard hall, as well as the sand area for children, which gave center an atmosphere the entertainment and fun for all family members, it is really a unique experience for shopping and entertainment.

Hijaz Market: Al Hijaz Mall is designed to include a variety of stores to meet different tastes and needs, and therefore Al Hijaz Mall has been able to gain great fame since its opening in 1998 to be one of the most famous malls in Makkah, which Makkah residents and visitors of pilgrims and Umrah performers do not dispense with because of its great importance and the many attractions it offers such as shops, restaurants or cafes, in addition to the games area.
